This conference is an annual two-day review of new and important topics in diagnostic surgical pathology. This two-day symposium is designed to highlight recent advances in surgical pathology with corresponding clinical correlation and prognostic implications.

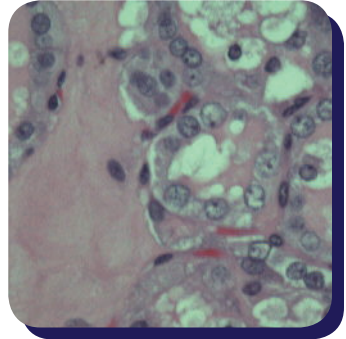
